

Splash House Rules & Policies 2016

General Park Rules

Patrons Guidelines

- Children Under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Height restrictions and rules of behavior are noted at each activity. They are for your safety.
- You are expected to follow all lifeguard instructions. No Running on deck.
- Proper bathing attire is required. No cut-off shorts are permitted. No Street shoes on deck.
- Approved swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained.
- Guest with special needs are welcome. Staff is pleased to provide the assistance.
- Animals are not permitted
- Swimming is prohibited during a Thunder Storm. Please follow all Staff instructions.
- This is an Alcohol, Tobacco and Drug Free Facility. No Smoking Allowed.
- The City Of Marion weapons ordinance is strictly enforced.
- No Outside coolers, glass, food or drinks are permitted inside the Splash House. Please no Gum Chewing at The Splash House.
- No food or drinks in the pools or the immediate pool decks.
- The Splash House is not responsible for loss of property or bathing suit damage.
- The Management reserves the right to take photographs and videos for promotional purposes.
- The Management reserves the right to limit admissions at any time.
- No running, rough play, or boisterous shall be permitted in the pool, on the runways, tubes, slide towers, in dressing rooms or showers.
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing of nose and other similar behavior in the swimming pool will be strictly prohibited.
- Please do Not drink the Water!
- The Splash House holds the right to CLOSE due to low attendance, bad weather, etc. Splash House will NOT open up if the weather is 65 degrees or lower.

You will be refused admission if:

- Your behavior affects the safety and comfort of others.
- You are suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- You have excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts or bandages.
- You show evidence of a skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes colds, nasal or ear discharge, infectious conditions or communicable diseases.
- You do not have a valid Season Pass or have not met the admission requirements for this facility.

Admission Policies:

- Season Passes May be Purchased at City Hall in Marion
- No Refunds or Rain checks.
- Children under 13 years of age may not be admitted to The Splash House without an adult 18yrs or older.

Bathhouse rules

- Help us keep the restroom clean. Report any problems to the Management.
- All Guests are asked to shower and use the toilets before entering the pools.
- Take all of your personal items with you.
- Daily lockers are available for rental.
- Swim diapers are required for children and toddlers who are not toilet trained.

Water Slide Rules

- Follow all lifeguard instructions.
- Only one (1) rider at a time
- Maximum operational load: 1 person 300lbs
- Children fewer than 48 inches tall are not permitted on the ride.
- No running, standing kneeling, rotating, tumbling or stopping in the slides.
- Never form chains.
- Slide must be ridden feet first lying on your back with legs firmly crossed at the ankles and arms folded across the chest.
- Riders must wait for the attendants start signal before starting the ride.
- At the end of the slide, obey all instructions by the splash house lifeguard and exit quickly.
- No swimming or flotation device allowed in the slides, or life jackets, or shoes.
- No Climbing up slide.
- Follow all the lifeguard instructions.

Kiddie Area

- Caution! Small Children at play.
- Do not run.
- No one over 48 inches may be on the kiddie equipment.
- All Children must be supervised by an adult.
- No Running and jumping into the kiddie area.
- No climbing up slides
- No hanging on the walls in the whirlpool area.
- No jumping into the whirlpool area or sitting on the sides or the whirlpool.

- Parents are NOT allowed to accompany children down the slide.
- Follow all the lifeguard instructions.

Lazy River

- All Children fewer than 48 inches must sit on their back with their feet up.
- No one may be in the lazy river without a tube. Stay in the tube at all times.
- No swimming or walking.
- No diving, running or Horseplay in the river.
- No Tubes in the whirlpool area.
- No one may sit or stand on the cement ledge.
- Enter only at designated areas. No entry from sides of river.
- All patrons must exit using the stairs.
- Children must be supervised by an adult.
- No food or drinks in the pool.
- Follow all lifeguard instructions.

Wave Pool

- Follow all lifeguard instructions.
- Waves alternate on and off at regular intervals.
- No diving, running, horseplay, or playing/hanging on pool ladders or playing with filters.
- No one may swim past 6 feet.
- Children fewer than 48 inches MUST be accompanied by an adult 18 or older.
- Children wearing lifejackets or arm floaters may not go past 3 feet unless accompanied by an adult.
- The only floaters allowed in the wave pool are lifejackets, arm floaters and noodles.
- All guests must enter at the shallow end ONLY, and NOT by pool ladders.
- Entrance may become slippery when wet, Use caution when entering and exiting the pool.
- No sitting on the wall of the wave pool.
- No sitting on each other's shoulders.
- No inappropriate PDA.
